## About the Speakers:

**LeeAnna Yater** is a graduate from the first Artist as Entrepreneur Institute that was held in 2009. AEI is a series of classes held on four Saturday's in June that focuses on the "business of art". She received her MFA from Winthrop University and has been a practicing artist, fine craftsmen & designer since 1985. Since the AEI she has been awarded grants from Broward Cultural Division to be an allied artist and also was awarded a grant to found and produce the DBA: Artists as Entrepreneur Exhibition and Forum. This year was its fourth year. She is the Florida Craftsmen regional director (area 8) and is currently producing a regional juried fiber exhibition. She has been an adjunct faculty of Broward College for 14 years and is invited back each year as faculty for the AEI.

**Kevin Kichar** worked in corporate management for over ten years before starting his own art career. He is a seasoned professional with over fifteen years of experience in exhibiting in art festivals and galleries. As a graduate of the first Artist as Entrepreneur Institute (AEI) workshop and a recipient of the Duane Hanson Allied artist Award from Broward County, he has advanced his career into public art with the completion of works for the city's of Plantation, Wilton Manors and Fort Lauderdale.

**LauraSue**, the Silver Nightingale is a flautist, vocalist and composer renowned for her angelic solo flute music, and spirited ensembles like Orquestra Nightingale and Laura and the Legwarmers. She's performed at exotic venues from San Francisco to Woodstock to Glastonbury, and opened for Judy Collins, Deepak Chopra and Marianne Williamson. Her debut CD, "Sarabande - Solo Flute Meditations", has been heard on radio stations from coast to coast, and hand-carried by fans to Sarajevo, Provence and other spots around the globe. Her recordings are widely used by teachers, nurses, massage therapists and others to enhance their professional and personal lives, and are available on iTunes, CD Baby and other online music outlets. Her website, especially her Birds Page and Nuclear Free Zone, is frequently used by teachers and students seeking environmental resources, and was referenced in the Kennedy Center's ArtsEdge program.
