Judges include photographer, Thomas Bollinger; artist and digital media sculptor, Marcia Moore; painter and 2014 Outstanding Visual Artist Award recipient, Jane Blatt; council board member, Tim Kimes; music educator and the 2014 recipient of the Excellence in Arts Education Award, Bridget Glass; and dancer, Anna Preston.
