PROJECT BACKGROUND:

Rio is a waterfront community along Florida's Treasure Coast boasting a scenic location along the north shore of the St. Lucie River estuary. Rio's residents are a closely knit group with the Rio Civic Club serving as the community's core. The physical character of Rio is representative of that "Old Florida" charm, mixed in with historical architectural features reflective of the period when the Spanish Conquistadors ruled. Rio's history is a colorful one which includes peacocks, Hollywood starlets, and "Ozzie & Harriet", a pair of osprey that return to this nest for several years to mate.

The work must be constructed of material (s) which can reasonably withstand the tropical Florida climate. Engineers on the project must communicate and be familiar with Martin County Codes and hurricane requirements. Installation materials suitable with a marine environment. Proper pedestal will be constructed onsite with artist engineer specs of the artists artwork. Martin County team will advise with the artist for proper mounting/install.

A stamped engineer design design is required from the artist after acceptance of the artist.
