The Arts Make A Vibrant Community

As the local arts agency, we advocate for Public Art in our community and to do so work closely with both the City of Stuart and Martin County.

- For the City of Stuart, we reviewed several projects including the Avonlea's proposal with artist, Dale Rogers, and are anticipating new projects including the Atlantic Point Marina.
- Working with the County we co-presented a reception for Gary Gresko's sculptures in Gazebo Park.
- Magnify was installed by artist Kirk Seese at the Cummings Library.
- Coming soon are a new sculpture for the round about in Rio along with additional bike racks and benches by Mia Lindberg.
- The Eco-Art project, Ripple was unveiled in September 2021 and led by artist, Lucy Keshavarz. Ripple reconnects the Old Palm City neighborhood with the St. Lucie River at three distinct sites along SW 28th and 29th Streets. Ripple is part of only a handful of projects across the county to receive grant funding from the National Endowment for the Arts.



Have You Explored the Award-Winning Martin County Arts & Culture Trail?

- The Martin County Office of Tourism & Marketing developed the Martin County Arts & Culture Trail. Created in partnership with the Arts Council of Martin County, this free, mobileexclusive trail features more than 40 local points of interest.
- The trail was launched in February with a corresponding scavenger hunt.
- A series of limited-edition glass sea turtles were hidden at each location, created by local glass artist Dot Galfond of License to Kiln.
- The program was a smashing success, and recently won the prestigious Destiny Award in the "Destination and Product Development" category, organized by the U.S. Travel Association.

COVID-19 Support: Received & Given

Seventeen organizations in Martin County reported a financial loss of \$475,000 since the beginning of the pandemic.

Federal (National Endowment for the Arts), state (Florida's Department of Arts & Culture) and local government grants were invaluable to the Arts Council, but also many of our nonprofit organizations. CARES act funding along with the SVO grants were a welcome relief.

To support the Arts Sector:

- The Artist Relief Fund established by the Arts Foundation for Martin County in April 2020, is nearly depleted. In the past year, 20 artists requested funding and a total of \$7,950 in grants was given to 16 individuals.
- Teacher grants with "State of the Arts" License Plate funding


