VOLUNTEER POSITION: Rover

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

You are the eyes and ears of ArtsFest! As a rover, you will walk around the site to see what's going on. It is your responsibility to contact the appropriate committee member if you observe anything that needs attention.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

Physical

- Comfortable shoes are a must as you will be on your feet for most of your shift.
